From the Turnpike

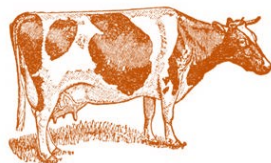
- Get off at Exit 266 - Lebanon/Lancaster Rt. 72 N.

- Turn at first right onto Expo Driveway.
